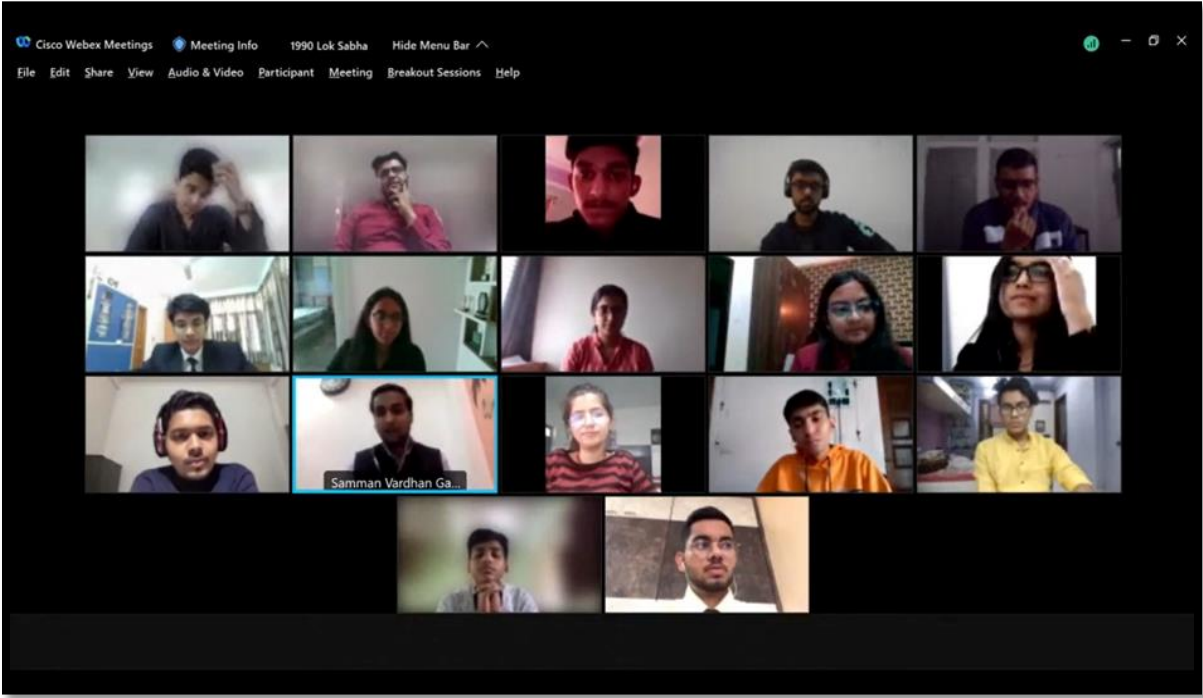
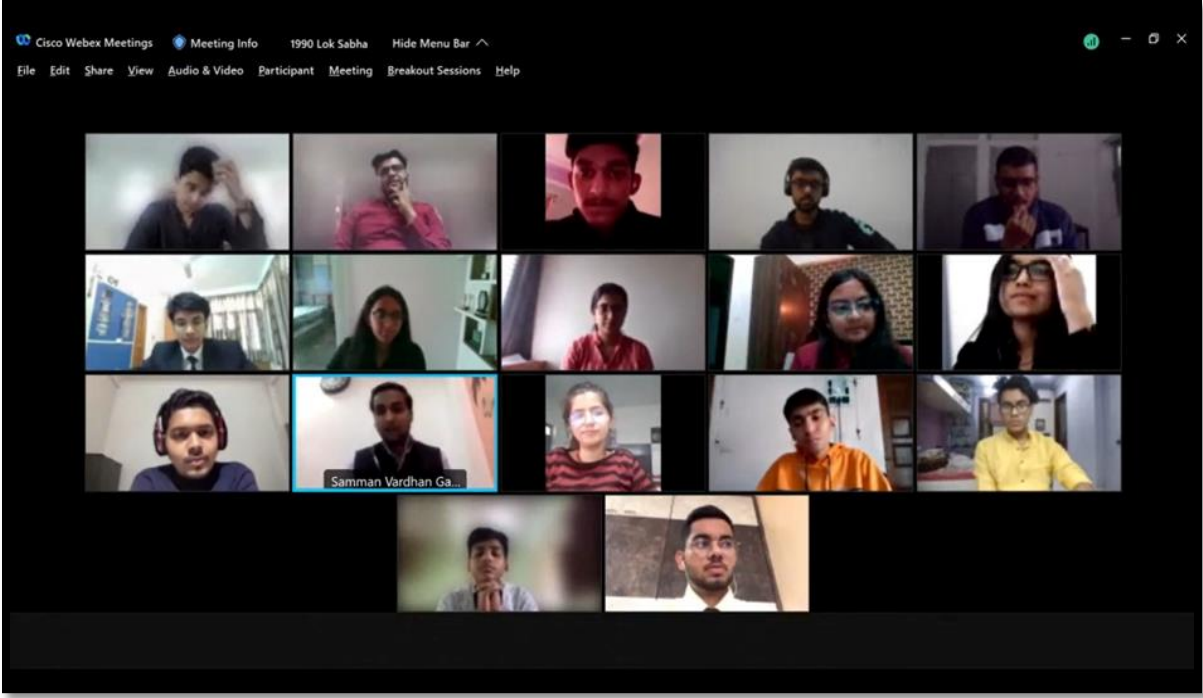
Description –
