




‘Each One Teach One’ in Women’s’ Central Jail

49. 3-DAYS OUTREACH CAMP

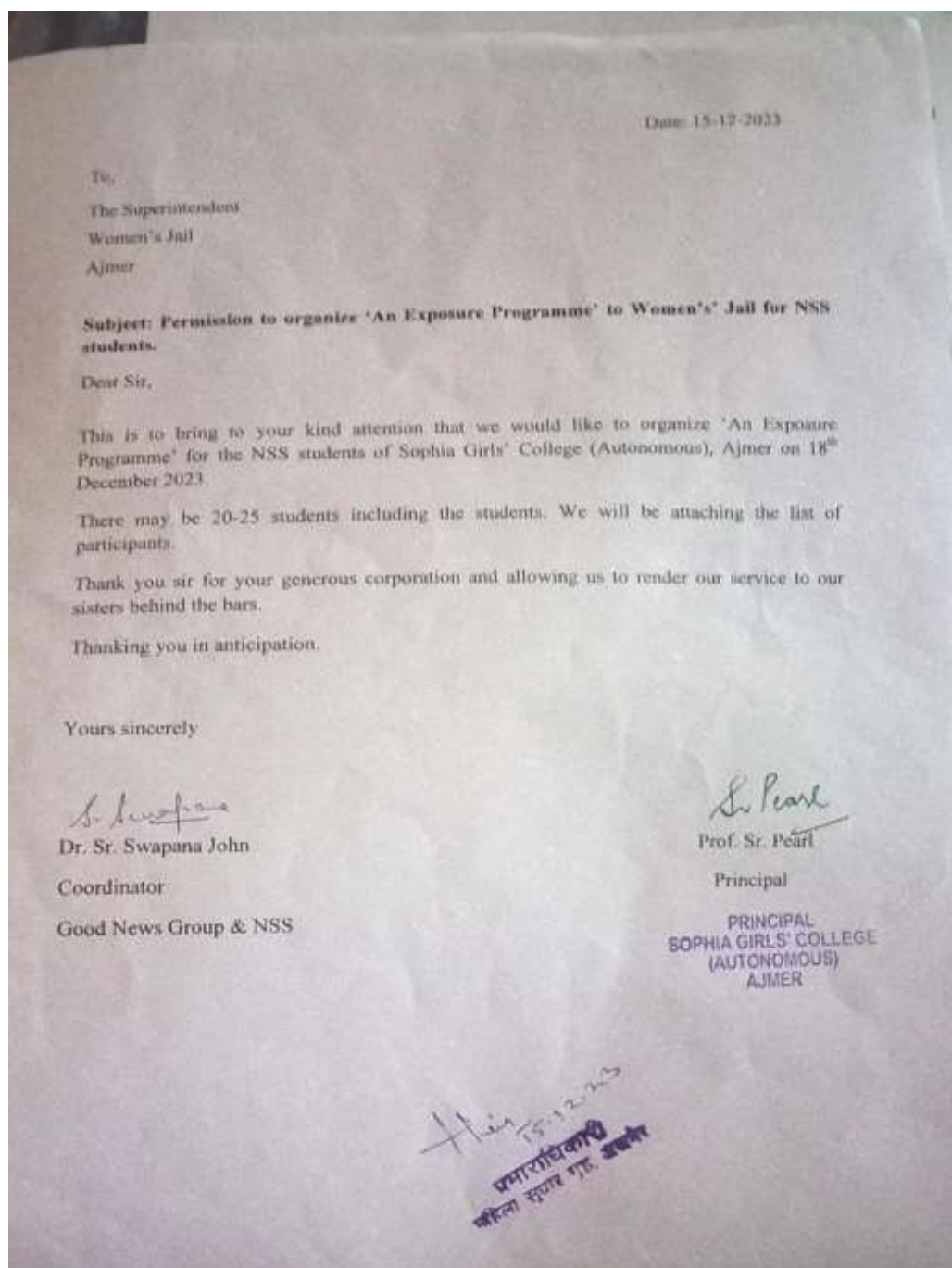
Day 1: 16th December, 2023

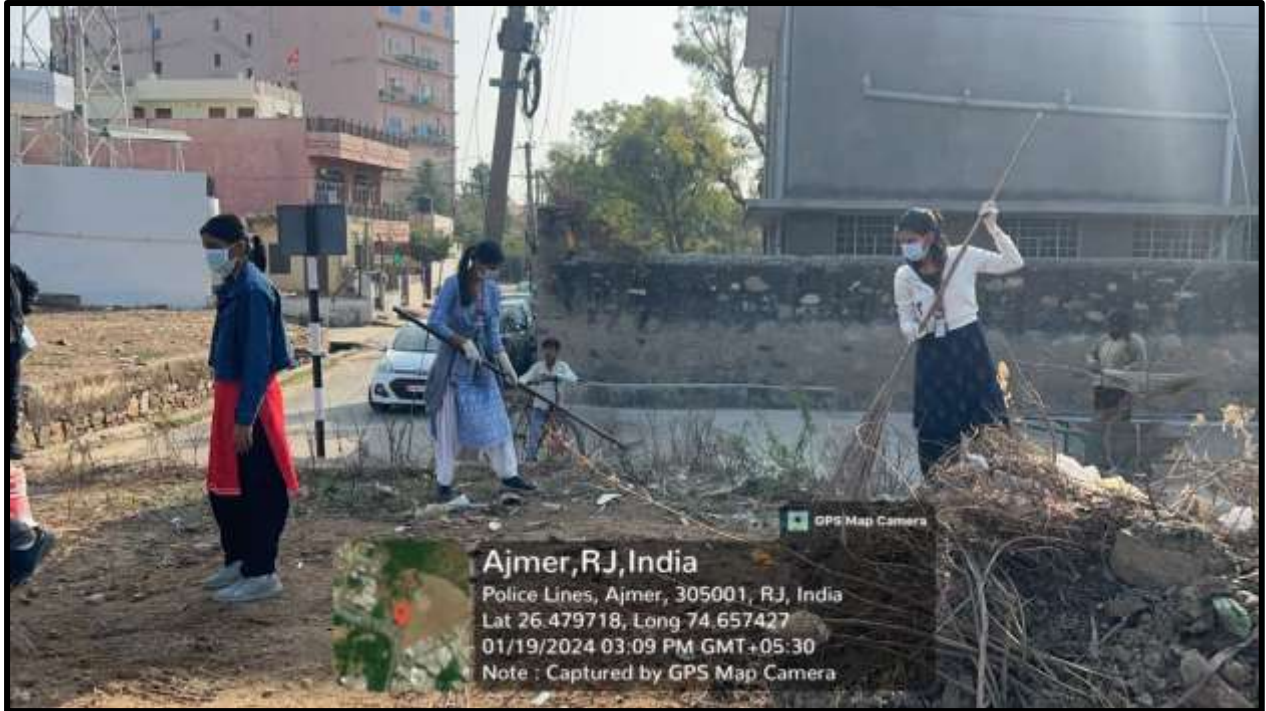

(Distribution of nutritional food to malnourished children)

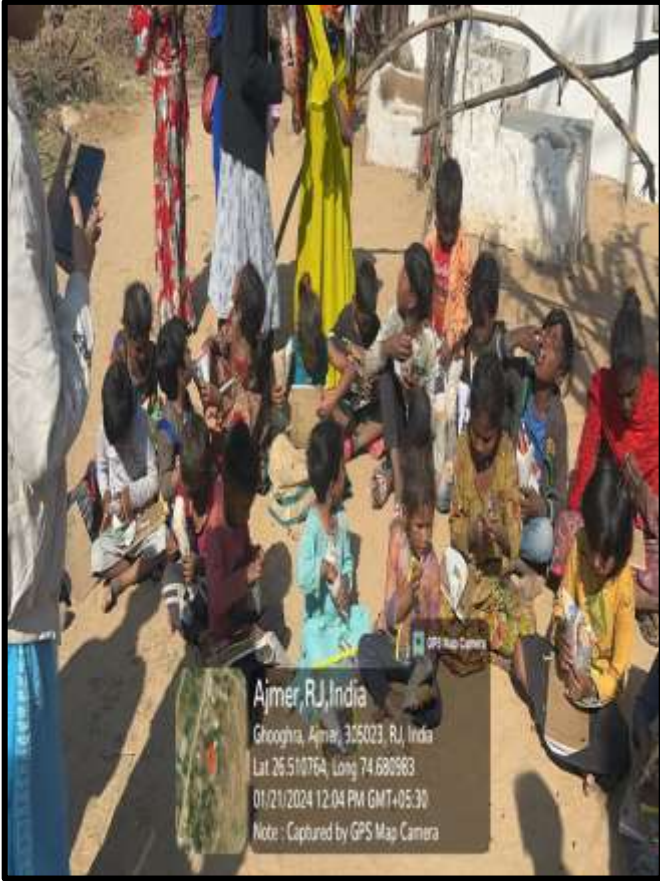




