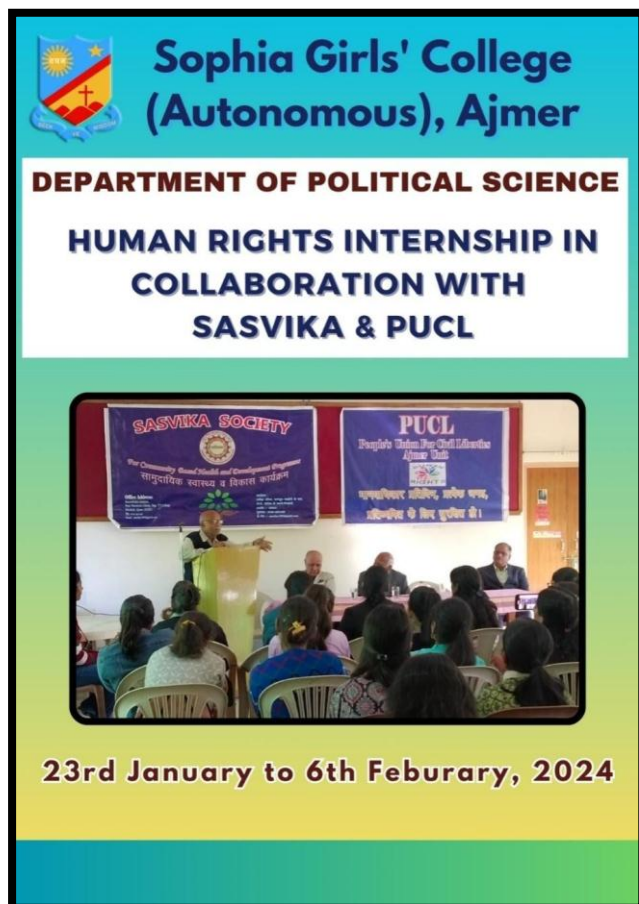
Lyceum the student's forum for the Department of Political Science conducted second edition of the YOUTH

visit.

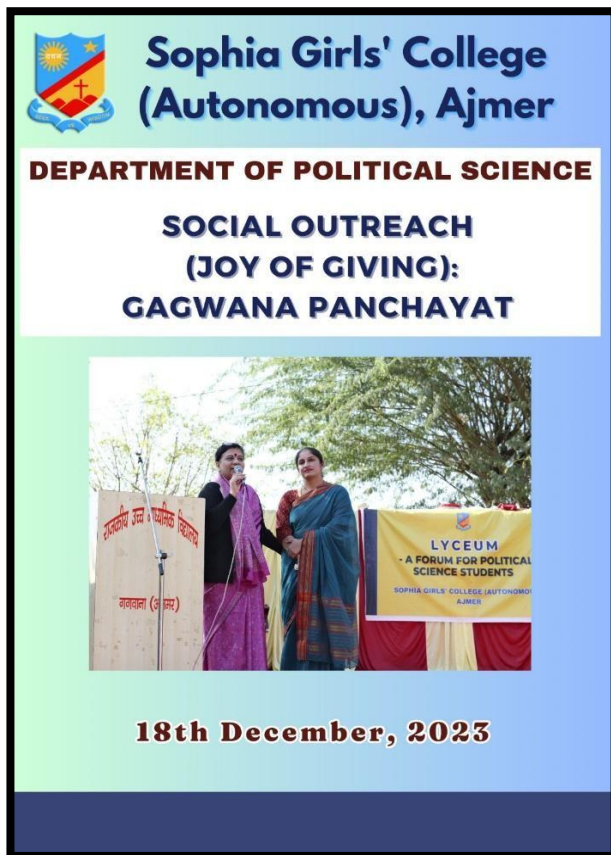

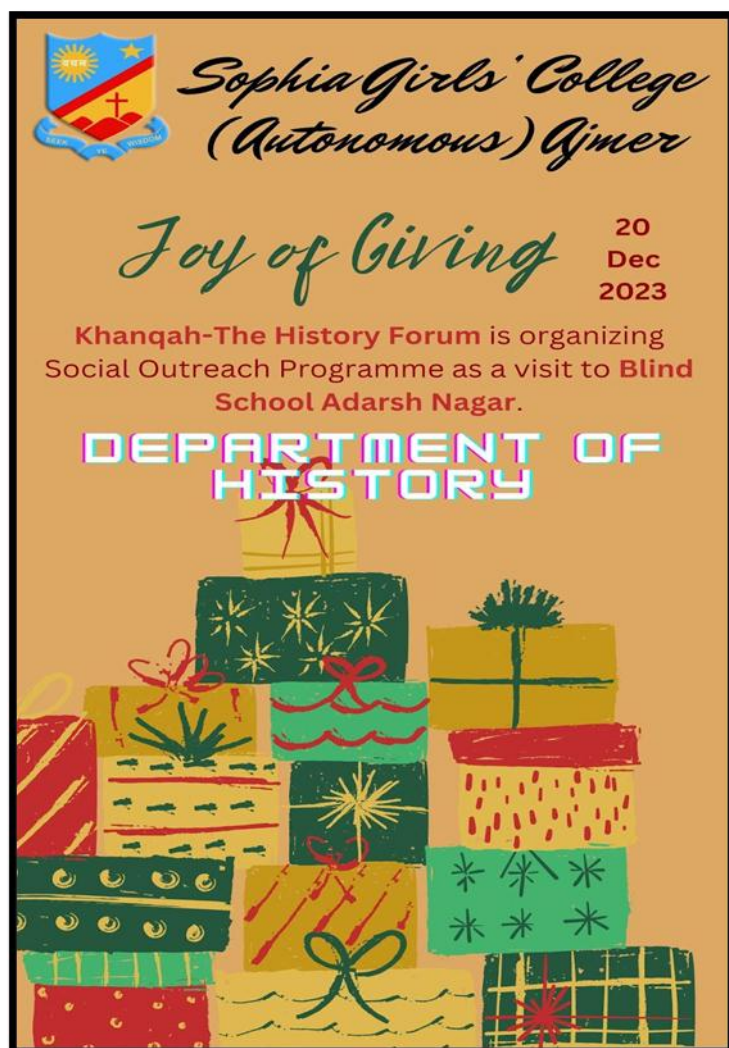
Seminar and quiz were organised on the occasion of Gandhi Jayanti. These events were conducted to commemorate the life and contributions of the father of our nation and to educate

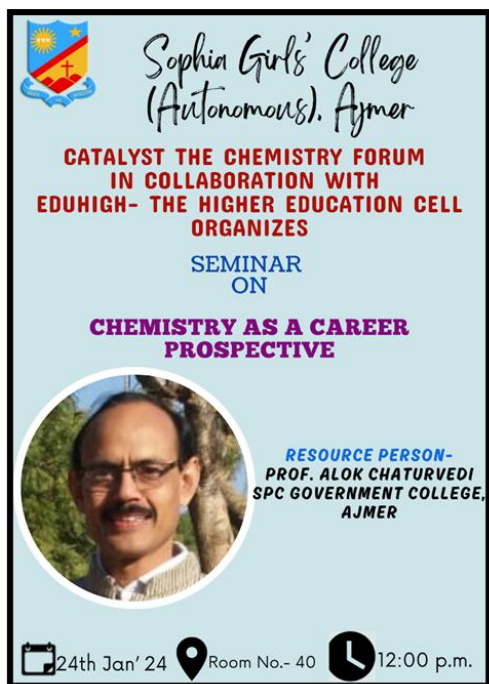
and games. The volunteers made the children gather and organized games in response to which there was full participation and enthusiasm.

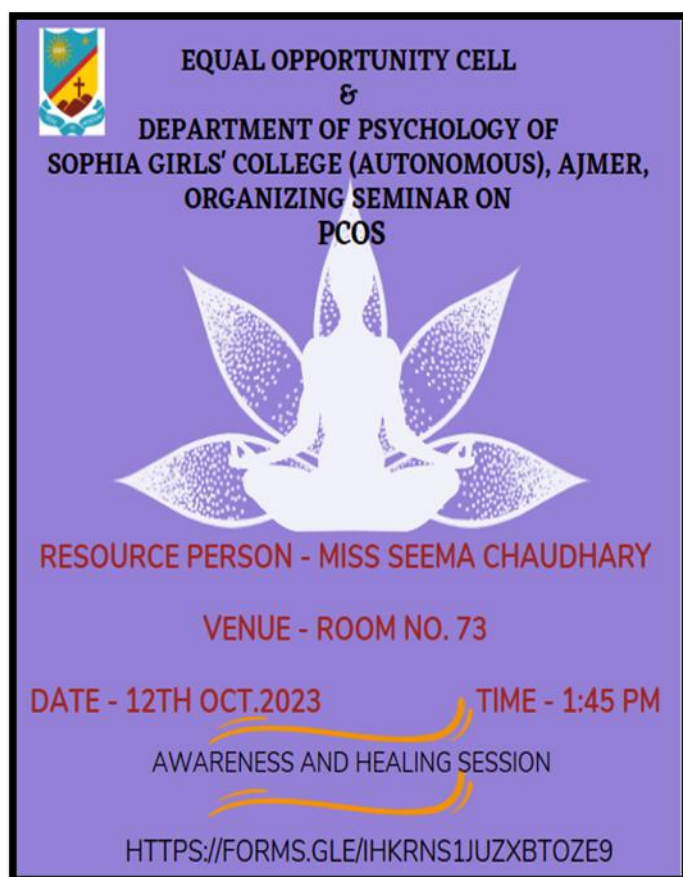
Description:-

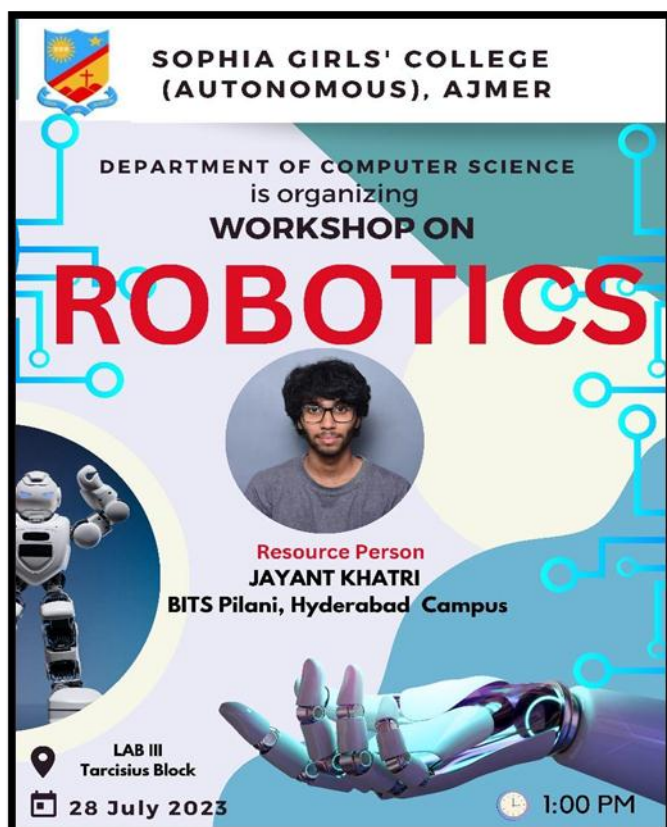

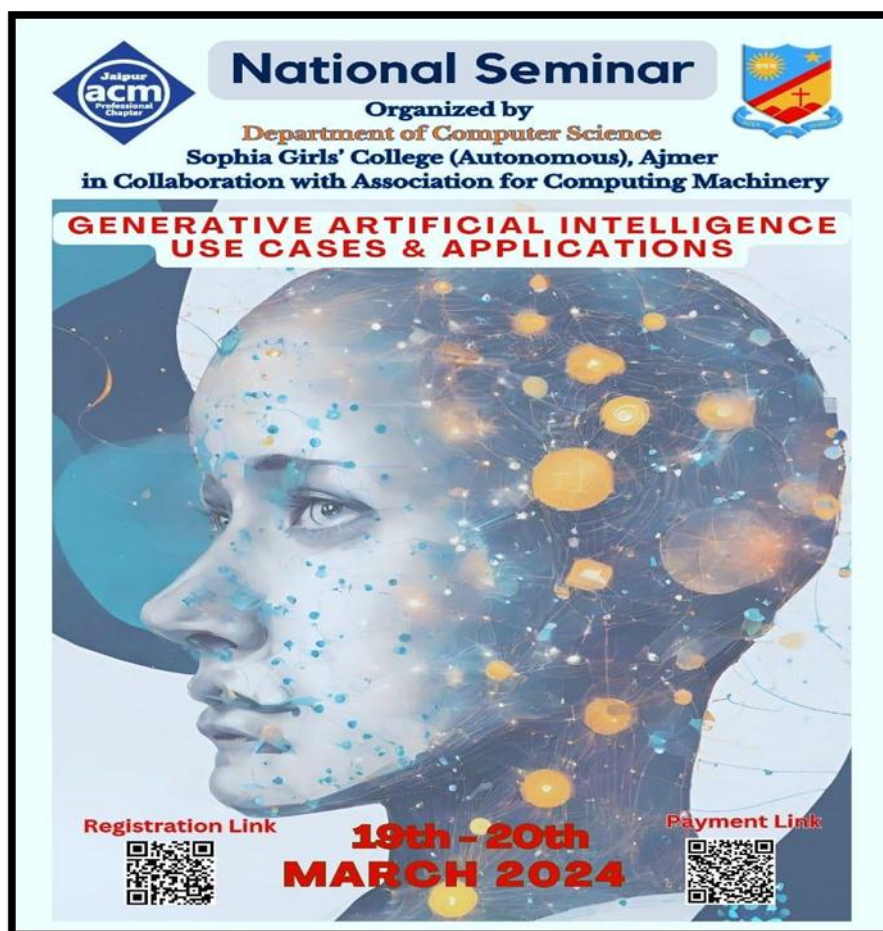
